## HOW TO RECYCLE YOUR WASTE VEGETABLE OIL?

(COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTAL)

### STEP 1

- COOL OIL



### STEP 2

- BOTTLE OIL (USE A FUNNEL)



### STEP 3

- STORE OIL



### STEP 4

- CALL ECOIMPACT OR DROP OFF AT AN ECO OIL BIN



## THE BENEFITS OF RECYCLING WASTE VEGETABLE OIL AT HOME

- Your household drains won't be blocked by solidified fats, oil or grease.
- Bacteria from oils will not overflow into water lines or soil.
- Unsavory fumes from residue fats, oils and grease will not affect the health of you or your family.
- You become an international contributor to feedstock needed for biofuel production.

## WHICH VEGETABLE OILS CAN BE RECYCLED?



You can recycle most vegetable-based cooking oils such as;

- Olive oil
- Palm oil
- Soybean oil
- Corn oil
- Sunflower oil

### BECOME A DROP OFF POINT FOR WVO

Businesses or communities that have a recycling program or would like to be a drop off point can request an **ECO OIL BIN**. Ecoimpact's team of drivers are on the road Monday to Friday for collection of WVO and regular checks will be made to remove the oil containers and maintain the bins.
