Recycling Bins across the Ecolodge

To ensure the conservation site remains free from materials that can harm wildlife, and to preserve the pristine, natural beauty of HADCO Experiences at Asa Wright Nature Centre, there are strict rules about separating waste, which applies to guests as well as all hospitality and maintenance staff.

There are multiple recycling bins across the facility for the disposal of the following items:

- PET and HDPE Plastics
- Glass
- Tetra Pak
- Aluminium cans
- Wastepaper
- Cardboard

The team from HADCO's Recycling Division will regularly visit the site to collect the recyclable waste and take it for further processing at our New Age Recycling facility. After sorting, the materials will be exported out of the country to be recycled and turned into new products.

Collecting Waste Vegetable Oil from the On-site Kitchen

For daily meal preparation, some recipes are cooked with vegetable oil. However, there is no discarding of waste vegetable oil down the sink.

Ecoimpact has supplied the on-site kitchen with plastic kegs to contain the waste vegetable oil after cooking.

This will prevent the clogging of pipes and waterways, as well as avoid environmental contamination and pollution of the water table which occurs if oil is discarded down the water pipes.

Team members will routinely collect the containers of waste vegetable oil and take it to Ecoimpact's facility to be cleaned and then exported to the United States, South America, Europe, and Asia as feedstock for biofuel production.
